- **Pre Matric Scholarship Scheme For Minorities**

Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt of India invites all the eligible candidates to apply for the Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme for Minorities 2020. This scholarship is especially for the candidate who belongs to a minority class. The aim of the scholarship is to provide an economic platform to the students of class 9th and 10th of minority backgrounds for preceding their studies. The selection will be done as per the board norms.

Eligibility Criteria

- A Candidate must be residing in India.
- A candidate must of minority class (Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Janis and Zoroastrians/Parsis).
- A candidate must be studying in class 1 to 10th.
- Family income must not exceed more than 1 lac.
- Must have secured a minimum of 50 % marks in his or her examination.
- The scheme is only for two students from a family.

Rewards Selected candidates will enjoy the following privileges

- Admission fee up to INR 500 P/A
- Tuition fee up to INR 100 p/m for 10 months.
- Maintenance Allowance up to INR 600 p/m for 10 months.

Important note:

30% of the scholarship will be allocated for girl students. If in case, rthe equired number of girl students are not apply for Scholarship 2020, then the scholarship scheme will be awarded to the qualified boy students.

PMS Selection mode

Limited number of Post Matric Scholarship 2020 for SC Category. Students who live below in poverty line (BPL families, having the lowest income shall be given preference in the ascending order. The renewal applications form would be fully shattered before the new applications are considered.

Post Matric Scholarship Amount

Admission, tuition fee for classes XI and XII. : Rs 7000

Admission and course/tuition fee for technical/vocational courses of XI and XII level. Rs.10,000 p.a.
