Dear Parents,

Greetings from Naipunnya!

As you know, our school has ever been proactive in developing the overall personality of our children. Keeping this in view, we are pleased to enumerate the following programmes which were organized in our school in the month of May & June, 2024.

- 1. Teachers play a unique role in students' academic, personal and social development. They mould students to reach their maximum potential by being a source of motivation and determination. By keeping this in view, a Faculty Development Programme was duly organized at Naipunnya Public School, on 27th & 28th of May 2024. The programme was formally inaugurated by our Executive Director Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan who spoke on the need & importance of upgrading and sharpening different skills of teachers for the betterment of our children. The sessions were led by Mr. Edwin Francis, Director of Language Resource Centre (EACT) International and Mr. Sinoj Jacob K, HRD Consultant & OD Advisor. Our school secured 100% result in both the exams. In Class X, out of 112 students appeared, 107 students secured FIRST CLASS of which 84 students secured DISTINCTION.
