Kumari Liz C Liyon(98.4%) and Kumari Nimisha P B(97.2%) emerged as school toppers in AISSE and AISSCE respectively. Out of 102 students appeared in Class X, the school secured 100% First Class and 82 students topped the list with distinction marks. In class XII, 100% distinction with 39 students securing 90% and above.


INDEPENDENCE DAY

Online Class Assemblies & Class Meetings






Naipunnya Public School formally introduced the TutAR App - a tool used by teachers in KG and Classes 1 to 5 - in the first week of July.


COMMUNICATIVE ENGLISH ONLINE




