Naipunnya is rich with passionate, enthusiastic and highly qualified staff members, which includes 86 teaching staff, 26 non-teaching staff, 27 supporting staff & drivers to give adequate exposure to the students. Staff meetings, Academic Council and Subject resource group meetings are held on regular basis to enhance coordination, foster a sense of unity and ensure everyone is on the same page. These meetings serve as platform for effective communication, collaboration and decision making among teachers.

The school currently has a strength of 1526 students. The school Parliament Election was conducted on 27th June 2023 in a democratic way through an electronic voting system. The elected office bearers are Master Elwin Poly- Head Boy, Kumari Abhirami C J-Head Girl, Master Angelo Sajan - Asst. Head Boy, Kumari Janna Rose Shiju- Asst. Head Girl, Master Daniel Sebastian- General Captain and Kumari Merlin Maria Danish - the Asst. General Captain. The Investiture Ceremony of the office bearers was held on 24th July 2023.

FACILITIES

Naipunnya caters number of facilities designed to meet specific requirements of students.

The year 2023 marked a face shift of the school. The change typically included a well maintained garden, a fountain and entrance pathways. School bus shed was constructed in order to ensure the safe storage and maintenance of school's transportation fleet. These changes aim to create a positive first impression for the students, staff and visitors. Our facilities include full-blown Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer - labs, Language lab, Maths lab, spacious auditorium, a fully furnished library and this year specially the most modern facilitised Media room is also available for students. Moreover, all the classrooms are well equipped with smart class projectors ,smart boards and interactive panels. Our school provides substantial transportation facilities, with 14 school buses for our students. We have a cavernous playground that contributes to the holistic development of students, addressing physical, social and emotional aspects of their growth. Our school is associated with 'ACE Sports , Edassery', a professional agency to render high quality training in the field of sports. In

order to make the mobility easy a lift facility is provided for the staff and for those students in emergency.

We have communicative English classes from classes LKG to X to foster the listening, speaking and communication skills of children and we have a full-fledged language lab for this purpose.

As we promote physical training, we provide one period every day for Health and Physical Education .

In addition, this year we started Pre Kg with all the adequate facilities under the care of a specially trained teacher.

RESOURCE ROOM & COUNSELLING

Resource room provides a specialised environment where students can access additional support and resources tailored to their individual needs. Counselling is essential for addressing behavioural and emotional aspects, fostering mental well-being and helping students to navigate challenges. We have professionally qualified counsellors Rev.Sr. Josmy Jose and Ms.Sona Sunny.

RESULTS

Our students of grade X and XII came out with their stellar performance in the CBSE Exam 2022-23. We attained cent percent results. 118 students appeared for the exam from grade X, 113 students got first class. Out of which 62 students secured distinction. Kumari Andria Antu was the school topper with 97.6%. Seven students scored 100/100 for Social Science, six students got 100/100 for Malayalam. Two students got 100/100 for Science.

All 88 students of grade XII secured first class, out of which 69 students got distinction. Kumari Anna Raju of class XIIC (commerce batch) was the School Topper securing 96.6%. Three students scored 100/100 in Malayalam. Kumari Sanya Poly is the topper for Medical Stream with 96.2% and Kumari Sonali Krishna is the topper for Non Medical stream with 93.8%.We really appreciate and congratulate all the students for their outstanding performance and we wish them a glowing future ahead.

VIDHYARAMBHAM

The inauguration of the new academic year was held on 1st June 2023 with the prayer service led by Very Rev. Fr. Jose Edassery, Vicar St. Mary's Forane Church Koratty. Vidhyarambham for plus one was also held on the same day. Our school magazine CHRYSALIS 2023 was officially released on that day. Vidyarambham for LKG was held on 7th June with the prayer service offered by Rev Fr. Paul Cherupilly Vicar, St. Antony's Church Edakkunnu.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THIS ACADEMIC YEAR

ACHEIVEMENTS

Nearly 140 Naipunnyans participated in Sugama Hindi Examination conducted by Kerala Hindi Prachar Sabha on 25th November, also nearly 236 students have registered for Mathematics Talent Search Examination by Kerala Ganitha Sasthra Parishath (MTSE 2023).

A team of our excellent students participated in the inter school Maths Fest conducted at St. Francis Assisi School Athani on 18th November. Our HS team won second prize for Maths Quiz and Kumari Aleevia Biju of grade X got second prize for the best Maths teacher competition.

This year in connection with Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) our students participated in scholarship exams for different subjects like Science, Maths, Social Science, English etc. Our students participated in CKS Kalotsav and secured 6th position out of the 100 schools and also bagged the first position in the off stage competitions. Our students also participated in CKS state level competitions and secured A grade.

Our team of senior Boys and Girls participated in the Central Kerala Sahodaya Throw ball tournament and both teams bagged the third position. The Kho – kho team of Boys and Girls of Naipunnya also made us proud by bagging the First prize in the CKS Kho-kho tournament

conducted at Marygiri Public School. Master Benjamin John of grade X A and Kumari Jisna Shaju of grade XII B were selected as the best players. Our school became overall champions in CKS shuttle badminton championship 2023.

A spectacular skating competition was organised by Fort Roller Skating Institution International. Our school became the champions in the skating Competition. Master Valentin Shaju of grade IX A won the first prize in 500 m Inline category and Kumari Ann Mariya Jomon of grade VII C won the third prize in 200 m Inline category for CKS skating competition held at Shantal Jyothi Public School, Muttom.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND COMPETITIONS

Students are actively engaged in a diverse range of activities, fostering holistic development and enriching their educational experience, help them to cultivate essential skills from leadership to team work, contributing to their well rounded growth.

Students are divided into four houses (Agni, Akash, Prithvi and Pavan) for various activities to improve their all-round development. Science, Maths, Theatre & Film, IT, Quiz, Literary, Hobby and Social Service (UNESCO) are the various clubs functioning in the school. We train the students in Art, Music, Western Dance, Classical Dance, Roller Skating, Karate, Yoga, Chess and various other musical instruments by competent instructors. A full-fledged band team is yet another attraction of the school.

An 'Anti Narcotic Club' 'VIMUKTHI' is running in the school as a part of anti-narcotics campaign launched by Government of Kerala. We Naipunnyans took an oath as a part of Anti-Drugs campaign conducted by Government of Kerala. A seminar on drug Abuse was organised on 29th September for the students of grade VI to XII. Mr Sidheek C A , Civil Excise Officer Angamaly was the guest speaker.

Annual Sports Meet was held on 21st September. The chief guest was Dr. Peter Joseph, (Winner and gold medallist for Mr Asia in masters category). The students entered into the spirit of the occasion in a grand way with great zeal and excitement.

Naipunnyotsav 2023 was conducted on 26th and 27th of July. The function was inaugurated by Mr. Manoj Guinness (popular actor & mimicry artist) and Junior Kalotsav 2023 was conducted on 21st October. It provided the students with a platform to showcase their talents, boosting confidence and encouraging a sense of accomplishment.

On 16th August, our Kindergarten team organised a wonderful flower's day celebration for the students. An exhibition was organised by the students of grade 1 & 2 named '**Incredible India**' on 18th August with a theme 'Unity in Diversity'. Each class presented different states of India in a unique way.

ART AND CRAFT EXHIBITION

We believe that art has the power to inspire, connect and transform lives. Art and craft activities at our school, groom the students in the art of living and working together

In connection with Children's Day an Art and Craft exhibition comprising hand-made articles and crafts designed by the students were organized. Moreover, "EXPLORE- 2023", an exhibition on creative items made by the students for different subjects is going to be held in the school next week. These events will have a profound impact on students by promoting hands-on creativity, honing fine motor skills and instilling a sense of pride in showcasing their creativity and talents.

CHARITY PROGRAMME

Charity is essential for promoting compassion, empathy and a sense of social responsibility.

A charity fund has been raised by our school with the whole hearted support of parents, staff and students for the treatment of dialysis patients. Every Friday students contribute for the same.

In connection with the Out reach programme, the students of class X were made to visit an Old Age home (KripaSadhan) at Karayamparambu on 26th of September ,

Grade IX and XI students also got an opportunity to visit '**Daivadaan**' an old age home located at Malayattoor

TRAINING AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT

After class hours, remedial classes of various subjects have been organized for the students who need extra care in their studies.

Monthly Class meetings are a holistic approach to education, promoting communication, collaboration and a positive learning environment for both teachers and students.

A sports training camp was conducted for the children in the month of May to enhance their physical fitness and skills in various games. We give coaching for various games like Football, Basketball, Cricket, Throw ball, Volley ball etc.

Special training sessions, seminars and workshops by experts were organized for parents, teachers and students separately. A Career Guidance programme on "Entry to NDA" was organized for the students of IX, X, XI & XII on 9th November by Mr. M N Jaimy (Wing commander Indian Air Force)

A career guidance programme was organised for the students of grade XII on 12th October led by Dr Jacob P M (Director of Naipunnya Business School)

On the occasion of Parents' day an Orientation class was conducted for the parents by Dr.Vipin V Roldant, a motivational speaker and performance Psychologist.

Our team of teachers are also attending Orientation classes and subject enrichment programmes by CBSE. In the beginning of this academic year a two days training programme named '**Team Bonding**' was organised in Niveditha Centre for Religious Formation &

Fellowship, Chunagamveli. Also four of our teachers have gone for NBN memorial teachers enrichment programme conducted on 25th and 26th November at Rajagiri Business School, Kakkanad. Students of grade XII got an opportunity to visit Naval Base and Navy ship at Kochi on 21st November.

HEALTH CARE

We have a qualified nurse to take care of students. We have arranged one period on a weekly basis to foster health and wellness among students. We had Health check-up for the students of grade IX to XII and an eye check-up campaign was also organised by Naipunnya in association with Dr. Tony Fernandez Eye Hospital Aluva for all students, teaching and non-teaching staffs from 18th to 20th October 2023.

Compulsory Yoga as well as Health and Wellness classes are arranged for the students of grade IX -XII

CELEBRATIONS

We celebrated all important days which include World Environment Day, Independence Day, Fathers' Day, Teachers' Day, Children's Day, Parent's Day and so on.
