STAFF AND STUDENTS

The preeminent team of Naipunnya encompasses the Exe. Director Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan, Asst. Exe. Director Rev. Fr. Christy Madathil, Principal Mrs. Rajalakshmy M. P., Activity In-charge Mr. Sudheer Kumar M.P, Discipline In-charge & UP Co-ordinator Mrs. Rejitha Joseph, Activity Co-ordinator Mrs. Asha Saji, L. P. Co-ordinator Mrs. Sini K.A, Pre KG, KG and I & II Co-ordinator Mrs. Tresa Mathew, Staff Secretary Mr. Shaji M.D. and Joint Staff Secretaries Mrs. Anu Treasa James & Mrs. Rani Thomas.

Naipunnya parades a set of excellent, passionate, enthusiastic and highly qualified staff members, which comprises 92 teaching staff including CCA instructors, 25 non-teaching staff & 29 supporting staff including drivers who are exceptionally dedicated to providing maximum exposure to the students. Three teachers are entrusted with the additional responsibilities this year, as Academic In-charge, Activity In-charge, and Discipline In-charge to oversee and enhance the overall administration and foster an activity oriented and disciplined academic environment. Staff meetings, Academic Council and Subject Resource Group meetings are held regularly to enhance coordination and cooperation in planning the academic strategy and to foster a sense of unity and ensure everyone is on the same page. These meetings serve as a platform for effective communication, collective and collaborative decision making among teachers.

The school proudly stands with an aggregate strength of 1525 students this academic year. The school Parliament Election was conducted on 21st June 2024 in a democratic way through an electronic voting system. The elected office bearers are Master Frederick Pio Kottackal - Head Boy, Kumari Asin Albert - Head Girl, Master John Joseph Mavelly - Asst. Head Boy, Kumari Sana Miriyam Naveen - Asst. Head Girl, Master Ashbin Biju - General Captain and Kumari Carolin Fobby - Asst. General Captain. The Investiture Ceremony of the office bearers was held on 10th July 2024.

FACILITIES

Naipunnya has ever been whole heartedly dedicated to facilitate the various requirements of the stu-

dents. A new plot of land approximately 52 cents adjacent to the school property was acquired for developmental activities and additional infrastructure in this academic year. The transportation fleet has been modernised by adding one Bharat Benz school bus with an aggregate number of 15 buses. Our facilities include full-blown Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer - labs, Language lab, Maths lab, spacious auditorium, a fully furnished library and a Media room with most modern facilities. Moreover, all the classrooms are well equipped with smart class projectors, smart boards and interactive panels. We have a capacious play ground that contributes to the holistic development of students, addressing physical, social and emotional aspects of their growth. Our school is associated with 'ACE' Sports, a professional agency to render high quality training in the field of sports. In order to make the mobility easy a lift facility is provided for the staff and for those students in emergency. A new cafeteria – 'Nais Café' was inaugurated by the Executive Director as a gift on the Childrens' Day to meet the requirement of the staff and students with healthy food items.

We have communicative English classes from classes LKG to X to foster the listening, speaking and thereby to enhance the communication skills of children. The school maintains a full-fledged language lab specially meant for this purpose. The English department has introduced a programme titled as "Empower English for Tomorrow's Excellence" to enhance the speaking skill, focussed on pronunciation and vocabulary for day to day speech.

RESOURCE ROOM & COUNSELLING

Resource room provides a congenial atmosphere where students can access additional support and resources well knit to their individual needs. Counselling is essential for addressing behavioural and emotional aspects, fostering mental well-being and helping students to navigate challenges. We have a professionally qualified counsellor and a special educator to scaffold the challenges faced by slow learners and to foster inclusive educational environment.

RESULTS

The spectacular performance exhibited by our students of Grade X and XII in the CBSE BOARD EXAMS 2023 - 2024 is matchless in the history of the results so far. We secured 100% results in both Grades X and XII. Out of 112 students appeared for the exam from grade X, 107 students got first class of which 84 students emerged out with distinction. Our joy knows no bounds

to announce that 44 students scored 90% and above and 13 students secured above 95%. Kumari Sreelakshmi Rajesh is the school topper with 98.2%. Six students scored 100/100 for Malayalam, and three students got 100/100 for Mathematics.

All 98 students of Grade XII secured first class, out of which 74 students secured distinction. 16 students scored above 90%. Master Leon Paul was the school topper and topper in Non medical stream with 98.2%. Two students scored 100/100 in Mathematics and Chemistry and one student each scored 100% in Economics and Psychology. Kumari Sarah Mary Shinto was the topper for Medical Stream with 97.4%, Kumari Angel Maria Joshy was the topper in Commerce stream with 94.2%, Kumari Monicka Poulse was the topper in Humanities stream with 93.8%. We cordially appreciate and congratulate all the students for their outstanding performance and we wish them a brilliant future ahead.

VIDYARAMBHAM

The inauguration of the new academic year 'Vidyarambham 2024' was held on 3rd June with the prayer service led by Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan, the Executive Director. Hon'ble Rtd. Justice K Abraham Mathew was the chief guest of the day. Our school magazine 'CHRYSALIS 2024' was officially released on that day. Master Aldrin Antu of class IX was specially honoured on the occasion for his unequal act of bravery in saving the life of a child from drowning. Vidyarambham for LKG was held on 12th June with the prayer service offered jointly by Rev Fr. Arun George Valiyaveetil, vicar of St. Joseph's Church, Josepuram and Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan, the Executive Director. The Vidyarambham of Pre KG 2024-25 was held on 6th June 2024. Executive Director presided over the meeting.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THIS ACADEMIC YEAR

ACHIEVEMENTS

Our school conducted SAFAL examination, a competency based assessment for the students of classes VI and IX as per the directive of the CBSE.

We are happy to announce that our school secured 8th position overall in the CKS Kalotsav 2024, held at Nirmala Public School, Muvattupuzha and out of 89 schools participated, we secured 3rd position in the off stage competitions. Our students also participated in CKS state level competitions and secured A grade. In the CKS skating Championship, our students proved their mettle by bagging prizes in junior and senior categories.

Our team of senior boys and girls participated in the Central Kerala Sahodaya Kho-Kho tournament and





both teams emerged as champions. Kumari Krishnendu B Nair of class XI B was the best player and best attacker in the Senior Girls category and Master Benjamin John of class XI B was the Best player and the Best Defender in the Senior Boys Category. The Kho-kho team of junior girls of Naipunnya turned out to be the runner up. Kumari Angalina Jogy of class VI A emerged as the best defender in the Junior Girls category. In the CKS Football Tournament 2024, our senior boys became the first runners up. Master Goutham Dev K Dinesh of class XII A was adjudged the best player of the Tournament and Master Benjamin John of class XI B was the best player of the match. Master Danny George Jacob of class V C won the 3rd prize in the CKS Chess Championship 2024, out of 500 students from 35 schools. Naipunnya skating team is thrilled to be the champion in FRSI Zone Skating Clash 2024. We are proud to announce that in the CKS Badminton Championship 2024, our school took home the 1st Runners Up title. Kumari Agnus Seby of class XII C and Kumari Maria Terez Mavely of class XI B won the first prize in the Under 19 Girls Doubles category. Master Pranav M Jaimy of class XII B bagged the first position in the Under 19 Boys Singles. Master Mehul A Pynadath of class XII B and Master Royce Jaison of class XI C emerged as the 1st Runners up in the Under 19 Boys Doubles category. Kumari Abhinandhana A A of class IX B bagged the second prize in the Under 16 Girls Singles Category.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND COMPETITIONS

Students are encouraged to involve devotedly in a diverse range of activities, fostering holistic development and enriching their educational experience and to help them to cultivate essential skills of leadership to team work, contributing to their personality development.

Students are divided into four houses (Agni, Akash, Prithvi and Pavan) for various activities to improve their all-round development. Science, Maths, Theatre & Film, IT, Quiz, Literary, Hobby and Social Service (UNESCO) are the various clubs functioning in the school. We train the students in Art, Music, Western Dance, Classical Dance, Roller Skating, Karate, Yoga, Chess and various other musical instruments by competent instructors. A full-fledged band team is yet another attraction of the school.

An 'Anti Narcotic Club' 'VIMUKTHI' is running in the school as a part of anti-narcotics campaign launched by Government of Kerala. International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking was observed on 26th June. A special pledge was taken by all students against drugs. The pledge was recited by our Executive Director.

Annual Sports Meet was held on 27th September.

Mr. Ajith Johnson, Asst. Professor in the Department of Physical Education from Bharat Mata College, Thrikka-kkara was the chief guest. Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan, the Executive Director hoisted the flag. The students entered into the spirit of the occasion in a grand way with great zeal and excitement.

Naipunnyotsav 2024 was conducted on 25th and 26th July. The function was inaugurated by Mr. Kalabha-van Niyas Backer, a famous actor and mimicry artist. Junior Kalotsav 2024 was conducted on 26th October. It provided the students with a platform to showcase their talents, boosting confidence and encouraging a sense of accomplishment.

Our Kindergarten team organised Seasonal Magic 2024, a wonderful show of various seasons. An exhibition was organised by the students of Grade 1 & 2 titled 'Neighbourhood Discoveries' on 2nd August 2024 to impart experiential learning by familiarizing the children with public places like Police Station, Post Office, Super Market, Hospital and Restaurant.

The karate grading session on 31st January 2025, provided students with a remarkable opportunity to showcase their skills and earn the grades they had worked so tirelessly for.

The 2-Day Retreat, held on the 13th and 14th of February, 2025, was a truly enriching experience for all the students of Grades III to IX and XI. The thoughtfully designed sessions led by Fr. Alphy Manavalan, on both the days proved to be not only insightful but also transformative, leaving a lasting impact on all attendees. Non-Catholic students were carefully assigned with distinct sessions, designed to meet their unique needs.

Special prayer sessions for Grade X & XII students were held on 6th & 7th February 2025 respectively. Led by the Executive Director, the session was a moment of reflection and positivity, with heartfelt prayers and words of inspiration from teachers of Grades X, XI and XII. A farewell function was also organized on the same day to honour the outgoing Plus Two batch. The event was a heartfelt celebration, filled with nostalgic speeches and emotional moments.

ART AND CRAFT EXHIBITION

We believe that art has the power to inspire, connect and transform lives. Art and craft activities at our school, groom the students in the art of living and working together.

In connection with Children's Day an Art and Craft exhibition comprising hand-made articles and crafts designed by the students was organized. Moreover, "EXPLORE-2024", an exhibition on creative items

made by the students for different subjects was held on 13th Decemeber. Our 22nd Annual Day Celebration was colourfully celebrated on 5th & 6th December 2024. Our Asst. Dist. Collector of Ernakulam Mr. Sanjeeth Singh, IAS was the chief guest of the day. On 21st February 2025, Classes I and II showcased their artistic talents at the Creative Hands Art and Craft Exhibition. The event featured a variety of creations, including wind chimes, dolls, flower vases, and more.

On 13th March 2025, Pre-KG students celebrated Shapes Day with excitement and joy. The event was graced by the Executive Director, Principal, Assistant Executive Director and KG and I & II Coordinator. Students explored shapes through a fun song and came dressed as various shapes.

These events will have a profound impact on students by promoting hands- on creativity, honing fine motor skills and instilling a sense of pride in showcasing their creativity and talents.

CHARITY PROGRAMME

Charity is essential for promoting compassion, empathy and a sense of social responsibility in the young minds. The students should be moulded to be sensitive to the needs of the people around them.

A charity fund has been raised by our school with the whole hearted support of parents, staff and students. Every Friday students contribute for the same. In connection with the Outreach programme, the students of classes IX, X and XI paid a visit to an Old Age Home in Chunangumveli. The students interacted with the inmates there and performed entertainment activities. Our school extended a helping hand to two staff members and handed over a total amount of Rs.70,000/-

Naipunnyans took to their heart the unprecedented tragedy in Wayanad and made up our mind to extend our humble help to alleviate the pain afflicted to the people there. A cheque of Rs.3,02,936/- was handed over to the District Collector, Ernakulam on 8th August 2024 by the Executive Director Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan.

SCHOLARSHIP

Every year, Naipunnya Public School proudly extends academic scholarship to our students of class X who score 95% and above in Board exams. This scholarship fully exempts the recipients from paying tuition fees for classes XI and XII. We are pleased to announce that a 10% tuition fee discount for the third child from the same family has been implemented this year. The Management has instituted scholarships to deserving students from financially disadvantaged backgrounds in

our neighbouring schools, to foster a culture of inclusivity and social responsibility. Students who demonstrate amazing academic excellence and exemplary character are presented with brand - new Naipunnya pens and key chains, by the Executive Director.

TRAINING AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT

After regular class hours, remedial classes on various subjects are being conducted for the students who need extra care in their studies. Monthly Class meetings are a holistic approach to education, promoting communication, collaboration and a positive learning environment for both teachers and students.

To empower the teachers, a Faculty Development Programme was organized on 27th and 28th May 2024. The training programme was formally inaugurated by the Executive Director, Rev. Dr. Bindo Kilukkan. The sessions were led by Mr. Edwin Francis, Director of Language Resource Centre International and Mr. Sinoj Jacob K, HRD Consultant & OD Advisor.

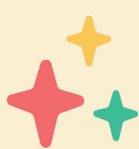

HEALTH CARE

We have a qualified nurse to take care of the students. One period per week is allotted for Health and Physical Education to all classes, with a view to foster health and wellness among students. A free health check up was conducted for the students of classes IX to XII by the school management. Compulsory Yoga as well as Health and Wellness classes are arranged for the students of Grade IX –XII.

'Water Time and Snack Bell' is implemented in the school this year to ensure that students drink enough water and take only healthy and energizing food materials.

CELEBRATIONS

We celebrated all important days which include World Environment Day, Independence Day, Fathers' Day, International Day of Yoga & World Music Day, International Day against Drug Abuse, Hindi Day, Teachers' Day, Parents' Day and Children's Day.
